**InfoTrac OneFile**      Full-text and citation database of news and journal articles on a wide range of topics, including colour images and referencing information (Titles include: *Child development* and *Journal of child and family studies*)

**NetLibrary**      Online access to Full text books (Titles include: *The Working mother, Moving and Learning series :Toddlers; Moving and Learning: Preschoolers & Kindergartners; Moving and Learning: Early Elementary Children etc*)

**Oxford Reference Online**      Fully-indexed collection of over 100 dictionary, language reference, and subject reference works published by Oxford University Press

**World Book Online**      This is a great resource especially for Teachers Assistants and Childcare students, but also for Encyclopedia knowledge
