- InfoTrac OneFile** Full-text and citation database of news and journal articles on a wide range of topics, including colour images and referencing information (Titles include: *Journal of social issues* and *Journal of social work education*)
- Oxford Reference Online** Fully-indexed collection of over 100 dictionary, language reference, and subject reference works published by Oxford University Press
